PURPOSE: The purpose of the Legacy Septic and Excavation Scholarships is to provide scholarships for current students of Winter's Mill High School, Manchester Valley High School, Westminster High School and Carroll County Career and Technology Center who are pursuing an interest in environmental science or environmental engineering and who meet the eligibility requirements set up for this scholarship.

The Legacy Septic & Excavation Scholarship

Criteria: Legacy Septic & Excavation is a local, family-based company that recognizes the future demand for innovative solutions in the field of environmental sciences. Our scholarship is to recognize and encourage interest in the environment. Graduating Seniors (one from each Winters Mill, Westminster, Manchester Valley and Carroll County Career and Technology Center) pursuing higher education with an interest in the environment. Cumulative GPA 2.5 or higher (no transcripts necessary) Award Amount: \$250.00 Each. Number of Awards: 4 (one for each school).

FUND SELECTION CRITERIA:

- A. FUNDS will be awarded to an applicant who meets the following criteria:
 - 1. The student will be a member of the
 - i. Winters Mill High School graduation class
 - ii. Westminster High School graduation class
 - iii. Manchester Valley High School graduation class
 - iv. Carroll County Career & Technology Center
 - 2. The student will have been accepted at an accredited college, university or technical school.
 - 3. The student will have maintained a GPA of 2.5 or higher for his high school.
 - 4. The student will have a demonstrated an interest in Environmental Science .
- B. The administration of the FUND shall be as follows:

1. The recipient(s) shall be selected by the Donors or their designee, and approved by the Board of Directors of the Community Foundation of Carroll County. Donors reserve the right to make the award presentation.
2. All income in the Fund shall be used for fund purposes.
3. The money shall be transmitted by the Community Foundation of Carroll County directly to the desired college or university and applied directly to the student's tuition and books. The monies shall not be remitted to the FUND winner.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

RESPONSIBILITIES OF FUND

The Community Foundation will transmit a check made payable to the institutions of higher learning chosen on or about August 1 of each year. The transfers will be in accordance with applicable regulations and laws governing such funds.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF BOARD

- A. The successful student recipients will be selected in accordance with the selection criteria identified in the Agreement.
- B. The Community Foundation of Carroll County shall administer the program in a prudent financial manner and the funds may be commingled with other funds of the Community Foundation of Carroll County.
