

Christopher H Knorr Scholarship Criteria

Chris Knorr was a dedicated individual who prioritized his relationships with friends, family, and community. Despite a demanding work schedule, he actively contributed to his community by volunteering in youth sports for both his son and daughter. Even after his children graduated from Century High School, Chris continued to coach, demonstrating his commitment to youth development. He also played a significant role in his local church's mid and senior high youth group, aiming to nurture love and respect among young members. In addition to his involvement in the community, Chris was a familiar face at Piney Run Park, local restaurants, and various sports events including basketball, football, field hockey, and baseball games.

Purpose

The purpose of this Fund is to provide scholarships for two graduates Century, Liberty, and South Carroll high schools. The scholarships shall be for those students who may need or request assistance to attend schools of higher learning appropriate to develop their capacities and capabilities. Need for financial assistance shall be taken into consideration.

Scholarship Selection Criteria.

1. Two scholarships will be awarded each year to students who meet the following criteria:
 - a. The student must have been accepted at a junior college, art institute, trade school, or four-year college or university by May 15 of their senior year.
 - b. The student must have maintained a grade point average of 3.5 or above, weighted, for their entire high school career. (Senior year calculated at end of third marking period)
 - c. The student must have had been enrolled at Century, South Carroll, or Liberty for their entire junior and senior years.
 - d. When all other factors are considered equal, consideration will be given to students who have demonstrated a financial need. A student can submit statement of financial need and resume which will be reviewed in the application process.
2. The administration of the scholarship shall be as follows:
 - a. Scholarships are one time only.
 - b. The amount of the award will vary based upon the earnings of the fund, minimum \$500 per scholarship.
 - c. The money shall be transmitted by the Foundation directly to the desired college or university and applied directly to the student's tuition and books. The monies shall not be remitted to the scholarship winner.

Student Responsibilities.

2. Please list your activities at your high school, community (including service clubs or projects), sports, civic groups and church activities in which you have took part.
3. Please attach a Letter of Recommendation from a teacher or a coach.
