



The Bernice Culver Memorial Scholarship

The purpose of the Bernice Culver Memorial Scholarship is to honor the legacy of Bernice Culver and her philanthropic wishes by providing scholarships for Westminster High School graduates attending accredited nursing programs or pursuing a career in the arts. Scholarships will be awarded to graduating students from Westminster High School pursuing an undergraduate degree in nursing or the fine arts who meet the criteria established for the fund.

FUND SELECTION CRITERIA:

- A. FUNDS will be awarded to an applicant who meets the following criteria:
 - 1. The student will be a member of the current Westminster High School graduating class
 - 2. The student will have been accepted at or already part of a nursing or fine arts program at an accredited college or university.
 - 3. The student will have maintained a GPA of 2.5 for his or her high school career and have college worthy SAT scores.
 - 4. The student will have a demonstrated interest in pursuing a career in nursing or fine arts.
 - 5. Fine Arts majors will submit a portfolio along with a corresponding artist's statement.
- B. The administration of the FUND shall be as follows:
 - 1. The recipient(s) shall be selected by the Fund Advisor or their designee. Fund Advisors reserve the right to make the award presentation.

2. All income in the Fund shall be used for fund purposes.
3. The money shall be transmitted by the Community Foundation of Carroll County directly to the desired college or university and applied directly to the student's tuition and books. The monies shall not be remitted to the FUND winner.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

RESPONSIBILITIES OF FUND

The Community Foundation will transmit a check made payable to the institutions of higher learning chosen on or about August 1 of each year. The transfers will be in accordance with applicable regulations and laws governing such funds.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF BOARD

- A. The successful student recipients will be selected in accordance with the selection criteria identified in the Agreement.
- B. The Community Foundation of Carroll County shall administer the program in a prudent financial manner and the funds may be commingled with other funds of the Community Foundation of Carroll County.
